

**RESOLUTION OF THE COMMUNITYCARE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
SUPPORTING CITY OF AUSTIN BOND INITIATIVE**

WHEREAS, CommUnityCare provides primary and specialty care services to individuals in Travis County and the surrounding areas regardless of their ability to pay;

WHEREAS, CommUnityCare conducts research regarding the healthcare needs of Travis County and the surrounding areas especially with regard to the indigent;

WHEREAS, the City of Austin has scheduled a bond election on Tuesday November 6, 2018 that includes Proposition E;

WHEREAS, Proposition E, if passed, will provide sixteen million dollars in funding for the design, construction, and equipping of a new neighborhood public health and human services facility in the Dove Springs area;


WHEREAS, CommUnityCare finds that one of the areas of high need for health care services is the Dove Springs area;
