Please bring verification of identity, residency, income and if applicable proof of any active health insurance/benefits to your eligibility appointment.

1. Identification Name must match one used on application.

Unexpired Texas: Driver's License, State ID, Learner's Permit or Temporary License

☐ If you do not have one of the above, you can bring one of the following IDs: Tribal, Student, Military, Department of Corrections, Metro or Government issued from another Country

☐ If you do not have anything listed above, you can bring one of the following: Student Visa, Matricula Consular, Passport, Birth Certificate, Legal Permeant Residence Card, US Immigration Document, Employment Authorization Card or Citizenship/Naturalization, Social Security Card

2. <u>Residency</u> Document must include legal name and address that matches one used on application.

Unexpired TX Driver's License, State ID or TX Vehicle Title, Vehicle Registration Card

Utility Bill, no older than 45 days, (cell phone bills cannot be used) or ¹Paystub

□ Business/government correspondence with name and address pre-printed (such as IRS Tax return transcript, verification of non-filling, W2 or 1099)

Copy of Lease, Rental or Mortgage Agreement

Document that shows you receive Public Assistance/ Benefits

Current Voter's Registration or Post office records verifying current address or change of address

Letter from Military/Veteran's Affair or Court Corrections Proof of Identity

¹ Paystub not accepted for SFS or MAP

3. Income for Each Member of Household (bring all that are applicable)

Employed: bring 1 month's current paystubs that show income

Student: bring proof of enrollment and financial aid

Paid in cash: employer must complete an Income Verification form (ask Eligibility for the form)

Self-employed or work as contract labor: bring a copy of your most recent tax transcript. If you do not file taxes, you will need Proof of Non-Filing.

Receiving Benefits: bring copy of benefit award letter

Supported by someone else: person providing support, must complete a Supporter Statement Form (ask eligibility for the form)

4. <u>Verification of any and all medical insurance and/or benefits, such as:</u> Medicare, Medicaid, Veteran's Health Benefits, ACA Marketplace or Private Insurance

Note, if you are homeless or undocumented, and are not able to supply verification of residency or income, substitute forms are available. Please ask eligibility for a copy and how to complete.
